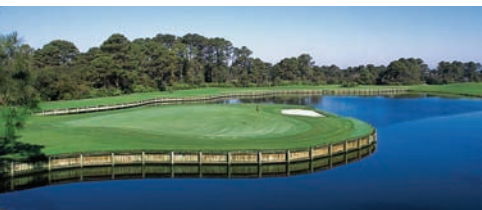

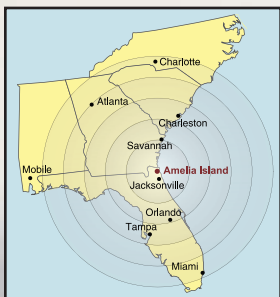

## Directions

### BY AIR:

Amelia Island Plantation is only 29 miles from Jacksonville International Airport. Private and corporate aircraft charters can fly directly to Fernandina Beach Municipal Airport, four miles north of the Resort. Transfers to and from Jacksonville International Airport, the municipal airport and the resort are available through the Amelia Island Plantation Transportation Department. Visit our website to make reservations or to check flight information online.

### BY CAR:

**From the South:** Take I-95 North to Exit 373 (Route A1A East). Go East 11.2 miles to Amelia Island Parkway (turn right at first traffic light, just over Intracoastal Waterway Bridge). Go 3.4 miles to traffic light and turn right. Go .7 of a mile to flashing light, turn left (Route A1A South). Go 2.7 miles to resort entrance on left.

**From the West:** Take I-10 East to I-95 North to Exit 373 (Route A1A East) and follow directions "From the South".

**From the North:** Take I-95 South to Exit 373 (Route A1A East) and follow directions "From the South".

**From Jacksonville International Airport:** Take I-95 North to Exit 373 (Route A1A East) and follow directions "From the South".

**Scenic Route:** Take I-95 North to Exit 358A. Go East on Route 105 (North Heckscher Drive) and follow the signs to Amelia Island.
